## 2022 WHITE WITCH

Our White Witch is a special blend of four white varieties with moderate acidity and a soft, creamy texture that pairs well with cheeses or seafood.

Marsanne, 22% Grenache  
Blanc, 6% Viognier

## 2023 CHARDONNAY

Our Chardonnay has aromas of pear, lemon curd, and melon, with vibrant flavors of Meyer lemon, Anjou pear, and buttered toast, and a creamy finish.

## 2021 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Our search for top Cabernet Sauvignon led us to Paso Robles and the Royal Estrella Vineyard, known for exceptional wines due to the unique temperature range in the region.

77% Grenache, 23% Syrah

## 2022 SYRAH

Appellation:  
Brosseau Vineyard,  
Chalone AVA

Our Syrah includes whole cluster grapes and a touch of Viognier, mostly from Brosseau Vineyard. The wine has a savory and briny nature, and will age nicely for 5-25 years.
